2025 Wirrina Tournament Rules

- Only fishing gear legally allowed by SA Fisheries state rules & laws to be used and all state bag limits will apply.
- 2. All Angler will be issued a numbered coloured wrist band that <u>must be worn</u> and used for ID for weighing & Correspond to the Angler it was issued too.
- 3. Fishing to start at 7am on Saturday weigh in at 7pm & on Sunday fishing start 7am weigh in finished 6pm
- 4. Any fish caught before 7am on either day will not be weighed.
- 5. Fish will not be weighed if it is not caught on that day and will not count.
- Only SBF Tuna will count and be weighed
- 7. Only one fish per person per day will be weighed & counted
- 8. All Fish Must be Bleed, Gutted & Gilled or Will not be Weighed or Counted
- 9. The Angler with the fish must be in the allocated roped off weigh in area before 7pm on Saturday & 6pm on Sunday to be counted/weighed
 - (Fish Can only be entered for weighing to the official manning the weigh area .)
- 10. In the case of any tied weight for any prize the winner will be judged by a count back system, which is:- (the first fish weighed by time, will be deemed the winner.)
- 11. All decision made by the official weigh master team will be final
- 12. All numbered wrist bands must be hand in on Sunday at the weighing station.
- 13. After the winners Presentation at 7 pm. There will be a Mystery weight prize draw.
- 14. Finally There will be the Anglers entry number raffle draw for over \$5,000 worth of prizes
- 15. To collect a prize in the entry number raffle the anglers number drawn must correspond to the angler that number was issued too & that angler must be in attendance to collect the prize or **it will be re-drawn**.
- 16. Any angler or boat caught & charged by authorities fishing in restricted area by law will be disqualified out right from the tournament.
- 17. The ultimate liability and or decision to put to sea return to harbour, or continue with fishing remains the competitor or individuals responsibility.

ARRIVAL TIME 2pm (unless otherwise arranged and subject to prior bookings)

DEPART TIME 10am (unless otherwise arranged and subject to prior bookings) Late check out is available for a small fee.

CHECK-OUT Cabin Guests please return the Cabin Key to Reception upon Departure.

SITES Powered Sites are marked. Please ensure that you are on the site allocated to you.

RATES 'A-Frame' Cabins \$90.00 per night (price for 1 x Adult)

Includes linen for Ensemble Double Bed.

Self-Contained to accommodate a maximum of 2 Adults and 2 Children.

'Pet-suite' Cabins \$110.00 per night

Includes linen for Ensemble Double Bed.

Self-Contained to accommodate a maximum of 2 Adults, 2 Children & 2 pets.

Powered Site \$25.00 per night (price for 1 x Adult)

CAMP KITCHEN For all to use! BBQ's, sink, fridge, microwave, coffee machine & mobile-phone charging for campers, adjacent to female toilets.

WATER Tap water in the main Buildings and on Powered sites is filtered and is drinkable, although is heavily chlorinated and isn't pleasant

to drink! Drinking water is available at the Rainwater tank aside the Kiosk.

Alternatively, bottled water is available for purchase.

PETS We welcome you to bring pets, however <u>all</u> animals must be controlled on leash at <u>all</u> times. Wirrina Cove is home to many

wildlife species including Kangaroos, Deer, Possums, Echidna, Koalas, Foxes and many varieties of Birdlife. These provide enjoyment for all and it is our wish for them to feel unthreatened in the Park, so please keep your Pets under control. Please

clean up after your Pet has toileted. Poo bags are available via dispenser near Men's toilets at the Office.

SPEED Please limit your speed within the park to a maximum of 10kph. Children have right of way on all roads!

NOISE You're welcome to have an enjoyable holiday but please limit excessive noise & all music to cease past 10pm.

Loud and disturbing behaviour will not be tolerated at any time. All noise to cease by 12-midnight!

RUBBISH Bins are provided throughout the park for your convenience. Please place all rubbish within the provided bins as the "local Crows"

have a bad habit of picking through accessible rubbish to find morsels to eat!

FIRST AID Basic First Aid supplies are available at Reception. Please phone 000 for Medical Emergencies. The Southern Fleurieu Family

Practice @ Yankalilla is the closest Medical Centre, with Victor Harbour & Flinders being the closest Hospitals. Please inform us

of any Incidents within our Park.

FIRES & BBQ's We welcome you to enjoy private Fires and BBQ's, however approval must be sought prior to lighting. Management reserves

the right to limit usage dependant on Weather Conditions and Fire Restrictions.
